Today on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 25 East Caribbean Financial Holding Company shares traded at \$15.00 and 125 St Kitts Nevis and Anguilla National Bank shares traded at \$3.28 both unchanged from their previous market close.

Also 891,450 units of Grenada Electricity Services' 10 year secured amortizing bond GES191217 traded at 7.00%.

And today's financial tip:

If I buy a company's shares just after they declare dividends, will I receive a dividend payment?

No. Shareholders must officially own shares at a particular date (also known as the record date) in order to be entitled to dividend payments. For example, a firm might declare a dividend on Nov. 1, payable Dec 1 to holders on record as at Nov. 15.
