On the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Grenada's \$12 million 365-day Treasury bill, auctioned using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange (ECSE), was over subscribed by \$0.4 million. A competitive uniform price auction methodology was used and the resulting discount rate was 6.0 percent.
