What is meant by ex-dividend?

Ex-dividend literally means without dividend. The buyer of shares is quoted ex-dividend if he is not entitled to receive the declared dividend. For example Jane bought 150 S. L. Horsford & Company shares ex-dividend from Jim two weeks before record date, in this case the dividend is payable to Jim even though Jane is the holder on record date.
