On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market the following securities traded:

- 1,470 TDC shares traded at \$1.50 per share, increasing \$0.10 or 7.14% from its previous closing price; also, 30 TDC shares traded odd lot at \$1.50 per share
- 750 Bank of Nevis shares traded at \$4.22 per share, falling \$0.03 or 0.71% from its previous closing price
- 300 Cable & Wireless St Kitts & Nevis Ltd shares traded at \$4.09 per share, unchanged from its previous closing price.

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the following auctions took place using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange:

- The Government of Grenada's 91-day T-bill raised \$15.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 4.50%.
- The Government of Grenada's 365-day T-bill raised \$30.0 million. The competitive uniform price methodology used, resulted in a discount rate of 5.49%.
