When I want to change the details of my Registry account why do I have to get the form notarised or stamped by a Broker and also send proof of my identity?

The account records maintained by the Registry are legal proof of your ownership of securities. These records are also used to determine your entitlement to corporate actions like dividends and interest payments, and your address is used for communicating important and confidential information, like your account statements. Therefore, to protect investors from potential fraud the Registry ensures that <u>any</u> change to an accountøs details is based on legitimate instructions from the owner or owners of that account.
