What is meant by trading volume and value?

The number of shares, bonds, treasury bills or other securities traded over a given period of time is referred to as the trading volume. Trading value is the total dollar amount of those trades. On the ECSE today, trading volume was 5,000 units of securities and trading value was \$11,471.50.
