Welcome to the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange daily update for 28 July 2011 providing the latest trading information and financial tips for the investor.

On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market today the following securities traded:

- 13,728 Dominica Electricity Services shares traded at \$3.00
- 200 Republic Bank Grenada Ltd shares traded at \$55.00; and
- 114 St Lucia Electricity Services Ltd shares traded at \$25.00 all holding firm on their previous market close
- 2,860 TDC shares traded at \$1.59, a decrease of \$0.06 or 3.64% from its previous market close
- 86 St Lucia Electricity Services shares traded odd lot in three transactions at a price of \$25.00 per share and
- 100 TDC shares traded odd lot at a price of \$1.59 per share

On the Regional Government Securities Market the following auctions took place:

- The Government of Antigua and Barbuda raised \$5.53 million through a 10-year bond at an interest rate of 7.75%
- The Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines' \$25 million 91-day Treasury bill issue was over-subscribed by \$12.16 million. A competitive uniform price auction methodology was used and the resulting discount rate was 4.25%.
