What is a dividend?

A dividend is the percentage of a company's profits paid to shareholders on record as at a specified date. The amount each shareholder receives is dependant upon the number of shares the shareholder owns in the company. For example, if Dominica Electricity Services paid a dividend of 20 cents per share, a shareholder who owns 1,000 shares would receive a dividend of \$200.00.
