#### **What is meant by Description and Symbol on the registry account statement?**

Description on the registry account statement gives information about the security or securities you hold. It states the issuer's name and the type of security issued. The security symbol names the security and distinguishes that security from all other securities held. For example LCG100116 is the symbol for a security, also called the trading symbol and the description of that same security may be stated as, Government of St Lucia 10 Year 6.5% Bond.
