What is meant by the term listed security?

A listed security is a financial instrument that is traded on an exchange. In our region it means that the security may be bought or sold via the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange. The ECSE currently has 13 Equities; 8 Corporate Bonds; 35 Government Bonds; 8 Government Notes; and 9 Treasury Bills listed for trading.
