Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

This week on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 2,000 Bank of Nevis shares traded at a high of \$6.01 and at a low of \$6.00 and 212 East Caribbean Financial Holding Company shares traded at a high of \$15.00 and at a low of \$14.50.

Regional Government Securities Market

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Saint Lucia's 180-day EC\$25 million Treasury bill issue will auction on Thursday 24th July 2008 and the Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines' 91-day EC\$20 million Treasury bill issue will auction on Friday 25th July 2008. Bidding for both auctions will open at 9 am and close at 12:00 noon.

In other related news, Grenada Electricity Services Limited (GRENLEC) became the 13th equity and the 3rd utility company to list its shares on the ECSE. The listing ceremony was held at the Grenada Beach Resort in Grenada at 2:30 pm on Wednesday 16 July 2008. GRENLEC, will be known to the market by its trading symbol GESL.
