## **Eastern Caribbean Securities Market**

This week on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 2,000 Bank of Nevis shares traded at a high of \$6.01 and at a low of \$6.00 and 212 East Caribbean Financial Holding Company shares traded at a high of \$15.00 and at a low of \$14.50.

## **Regional Government Securities Market**

On the Regional Government Securities Market, the Government of Saint Lucia's 180-day EC\$25 million Treasury bill issue will auction on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2008 and the Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines' 91-day EC\$20 million Treasury bill issue will auction on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2008. Bidding for both auctions will open at 9 am and close at 12:00 noon.

In other related news, Grenada Electricity Services Limited (GRENLEC) became the 13<sup>th</sup> equity and the 3<sup>rd</sup> utility company to list its shares on the ECSE. The listing ceremony was held at the Grenada Beach Resort in Grenada at 2:30 pm on Wednesday 16 July 2008. GRENLEC, will be known to the market by its trading symbol GESL.
