Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market this week, 25 shares of Dominica Electricity Services traded at \$4.00, 29 shares of TDC traded at \$13.00 and 1,500 shares of East Caribbean Financial Holding Company traded in a range of \$9.75 to \$10.00. The share prices of Dominica Electricity Services and TDC held firm during the week, while East Caribbean Financial Holding Company started the week at \$10.00 and declined by 25 cents, closing the week at \$9.75.
