

Summary trading report for the week ending Friday, 25th July 2008

Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

This week on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 2,633 Cable & Wireless St Kitts & Nevis shares traded at \$6.50, 150 East Caribbean Financial Holding Company shares traded at \$15.00, 9,600 TDC shares traded at \$1.75 all unchanged from its previous traded prices, 1,157 St Kitts Nevis Anguilla National Bank shares traded at a high of \$3.00 and at a low of \$2.90. Also, 250,000 units of the Government of Saint Lucia's 5-year Treasury note LCN090713 traded at 6.80% and 218,000 units of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 7-year US dollar bond FAG070713 traded at 8.00%.

Regional Government Securities Market

On the Regional Government Securities Market, The Government of Saint Lucia's 180-day, \$25 million Treasury bill issue, auctioned on the Regional Government Securities Market using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange was over-subscribed by \$7.579 million. A competitive uniform price auction methodology was used and the resulting discount rate was 5.20 per cent.

Also, The Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines' 91-day, \$20 million Treasury bill issue, auctioned on the Regional Government Securities Market using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange was over-subscribed by \$2.168 million. A competitive uniform price auction methodology was used and the resulting discount rate was 5.82 per cent.

The next auction will take place on Tuesday July 29th and Wednesday July 30th where the Government of Saint Lucia will auction an EC\$70 million 10 year 7.50% bond. Bidding for this auction will open at 9 am and close at 12:00 noon.

In other related news, Grenreal Property Corporation Limited (Grenreal) became the fourteenth equity and first real estate company to list its shares on the ECSE. The listing ceremony was held in Grenada at the Esplanade Mall on Monday 21st July 2008 at 9:00 am. Grenreal, will be known to the market by its trading symbol GPCL.
