Summary trading report for the week ending Friday, 26 October 2007

### **Eastern Caribbean Securities Market**

This week on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market, 2,120 Bank of Nevis shares traded at \$5.00, a fifty cents decrease or 9.10% on last week's close, 100 shares of Dominica Electricity Services traded at \$3.50, unchanged since its previous trading price, 556 shares of East Caribbean Financial Holding Company traded at \$12.50, holding firm on its last closing price, and 30 TDC shares traded at \$13.50, an increase of fifty cents or 3.84% on last week's close.

Also, 5,000 units of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda's 91-day treasury bill, AGB311207 traded at 6.50%.

### **Regional Government Securities Market**

The Government of Antigua and Barbuda will auction a \$17M 91-day treasury bill on November 2nd, 2007. Bidding for this auction begins at 9:00 am on Friday 2nd November and ends at 12:00 using the primary market platform of the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange.
