Summary Trading Report for the week ending Friday, 4th August 2006

Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

Shares of Dominica Electricity Services, S L Horsford and Company and St Kitts Nevis Anguilla National Bank traded on the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market this week. 100 shares of Dominica Electricity Services traded at \$4.00, an increase of \$1.00 or 33.3% on its previous market close, 1,330 shares of S L Horsford and Company traded at \$1.70, an increase of 40 cents or 30.8% on its previous market close, and 100 shares of St Kitts Nevis Anguilla National Bank traded at \$3.00 per share, holding firm on its previous market close.

Following the increase in these two companies' share-price, the EC-Share Index now stands at 117.01, an increase of 6.8% since January 1st, 2006.

Regional Government Securities Market

On the Regional Government Securities Market, there was no trading activity this week. However, the Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines will hold its monthly auction of \$16M in 91-day treasury bills next Wednesday, 9th August 2006. The Government of St Vincent and the Grenadines has also issued a prospectus for a \$40M, 7.5%, 10-year bond issue to be auctioned via the ECSE's primary market platform on 15th and 16th August 2006.
