The acronym DRIP means Dividend Reinvestment Plan. For some companies this is an option to make dividend payments. Automatically, the shareholder's dividend payment is made in shares instead of cash. For example, an ECFH shareholder who chooses to reinvest his entire dividend of \$158.00 will receive 20 additional ECFH shares
